**GENERAL REVELATION AND NATURAL THEOLOGY.**

**SPECIAL REVELATION.**  
**Special revelation is only received through Scripture, and only occasionally have men received special revelation any other way. This study will focus on the book of Hebrews as we gain a fuller understanding of the revelation of God to us.**

**INSPIRATION AND AUTHORITY OF SCRIPTURE.**  
**The primary cause of the Reformation was the doctrine of justification by faith alone. But what about authority? This study leads us, through II Timothy to the nature of inspiration.**

**Sunday, March 14, 2010.**

**INFALLIBILITY AND INERRANCY.**  
**The question of the authority of the Bible rests upon the authority of Christ. In this study we will determine the difference between infallibility and inerrancy.**

**CANONICITY.**

**What is the Holy Bible? What is the canon and its scope? In this study we will form a better understanding of how the various books and letters came to be included in the Bible.**

**Sunday, March 28, 2010**

**SCRIPTURE AND AUTHORITY.**

**In today's study Sproul helps us to understand the relationship between Scripture and tradition. We tend to speak in abstract terms about the nature of God's revelation to us. But when we don't fully understand the content of His revelation, we cannot understand His will for us in faith or practice.**
